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## About Us



**AGAPE GIVER** is a non-profit organization that supports children with Special Needs. It was founded on August 5th, 2019, and registered on November 24th, 2020. We provide basic needs, health care special education and aid equipment etc to the differently abled children

We also offer counseling and encouragement to the children's parents, care takers and families in general. Through counseling and encouragement to their families, hope is restored to them.

Agape Giver preaches the Gospel of JESUS CHRIST by reminding these families of God's unconditional love to them no matter their situations.

Through AGAPE GIVER, there's promotion of public sensitization and awareness about acceptance plus inclusion of children living with special needs or disability. People are made aware of the dangers of stigmatization to such individuals because they matter too.

Agape Giver's projects and activities are seventy percent (70%) sustained through donations from individuals, well-wishers, communities support groups and other organizations.



# Our Work

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**AGAPE GIVER** is built on a Christian faith-based foundation. Every decision and all activities are Christ-centered. The founder of Agape Giver, Pamella Kagombe works jointly with a board of directors and a team of dedicated volunteers to realize the objectives, mission and vision of the organization.

These teams are devoted to ensuring that the lives of our young beneficiaries are touched and improved, through out reaches/ missions across Uganda.

We collect donations in form of items and cash from individuals, support groups, and other well-wishers. These collections help our children receive items like aid equipment (wheelchairs, hearing aids, crutches, etc.), foodstuffs, beddings, clothes, shoes, toys, school fees and health care supplies.

We carry out outreaches bi-annually in (**May and December**) where we invite everybody to join and support the great mission of improving and impacting a life of a vulnerable child with special needs.

Due to living a life of special needs, JOEL used to struggle with challenges like being bullied by his fellow children, being miss understood by many people due to his speech impairment and slow mobility which is caused by his limb-length discrepancy among others.


AGAPE GIVER, addressed some of these challenges by enrolling him to a special needs school which now caters for his special needs through inclusion, acceptance and therapy. It is fulfilling to report that JOEL is now a happy boy and his life style is much improved.




